For parents of children returning to us in September, you will receive information regarding your child's new Key Worker within the first two weeks of September. Your child's Key Worker is the adult who will predominantly interact with your child throughout their day, keeping a record of observations on your child's learning and development, and plan activities to help your child develop even further. This is the adult that you should make initial contact with if you have any questions/concerns about your child or nursery in general.

We will also be holding 'initial progress' meetings with parents, both existing and new, to let you know how your child has settled into nursery and to share the development expectations/targets with you. The meetings will also give you chance to meet the staff in your child's room and ask any questions that you may have about nursery.
